

Mohs' Micrographic Surgery

(Pre-operative Instructions)

Department of Dermatology

- 1. If you are taking Aspirin or Warfarin please inform the doctor or nurse if you have not been given any special instructions.
- 2. Maintain your normal intake of food and liquids during the days prior to surgery. Please have breakfast the morning of your surgery.
- 3. Wash your hair the night before, or the morning of surgery. You may not be able to shower for 24-48 hours after surgery.
- 4. Wear comfortable clothes which can be pulled loosely over your head after the surgery.
- 5. Remove all make-up from the area of the operation on the day of your surgery.
- 6. Plan to have someone available to take you home after the surgery. We recommend you are not alone for the first night following surgery.
- 7. Please avoid smoking 2 weeks before and 2 weeks after your surgery as it may seriously impair your wound healing.
- 8. A large part of the time during Mohs' surgery is spent waiting for laboratory and microscopic examination, so bring reading material if you wish. You may bring snacks.

 A friend or relative may wait with you during the day.

Please notify the nurse or doctor of any changes in your health prior to surgery.

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
