General information about the Hospital Chaplaincy Service

The members of the hospital chaplaincy team are here to provide pastoral, spiritual or religious support where appropriate for those of all faiths and none, according to their individual needs.

The chaplains seek to:

- Offer a listening ear.
- Provide pastoral care.
- Be a resource for spiritual and / or religious care.
- Lead worship, offer prayer and administer the sacraments.
- Offer a source of support to patients, their families and to staff.
- Support the work of staff as an additional element for patient care.
- Offer confidential support to members of staff.

Who are the Chaplains?

The hospital Chaplains are ordained and accredited ministers who specialise in the health care setting. They come from different local denominations and faiths but work together as a team to provide good quality pastoral, religious and spiritual care.

Wherever possible, the Chaplains will work to connect people to leaders from their own personal faith tradition if they have one.

Chapels, or Multi Faith rooms are available on most main sites. Chaplains are usually on site during office hours in the Royal Gwent, Nevill Hall and Ystrad Mynach.
