Welcome to the fourth joint edition of the Tredegar Health and Wellbeing Centre newsletter from Kier Construction Western and Wales, in partnership with Aneurin Bevan University Health Board (ABUHB).

We are pleased to announce that the site has officially been named as The Bevan Health & Wellbeing Centre.

The new facility, which is due to be completed in April 2023, will provide a comprehensive range of Primary Care, Community, Social Care and Wellbeing services together in one place for local residents.

Following a public discussion on the official name of the centre, The Bevan Health & Wellbeing Centre was chosen by Ann Lloyd CBE, Chair of Aneurin Bevan University Health Board, and Glyn Jones, Interim Chief Executive, from a selection of suggested titles.

Ann Lloyd CBE, Chair of Aneurin Bevan University Health Board, said:

"We received some excellent name suggestions for the new building, but The Bevan Health and Wellbeing Centre seemed the most fitting for a centre built in the hometown of the founder of the NHS."

Glyn Jones, Interim Chief Executive of Aneurin Bevan University Health Board, said:

"It was an honour to be able to choose the name of the centre, and we're thrilled to see the construction of this fantastic new facility, which will offer excellent health care services closer to residents' homes."

Project Update

The site has changed dramatically since photographs were last taken

back in November 2021, with an impressive steel frame and concrete flooring now in place. To keep people up to date with the development we have recently taken some new photos and video footage of the site 'beyond the hoarding' to document the construction progress.

Works are now progressing on the envelope of the building. The Cladding, flat roofing and window installation works will be the next significant activities to commence and are due to start during May and early June.



Heart Building works are also ongoing with the building now strapped to the main steel

frame. The next phase of works is to remove the old roof and internal partitions and install a new steel support frame inside the structure, which will ultimately carry the new roof.

The new drainage connections into Market Street have now been completed and Kier would like to take this opportunity to thank the residents for their co-operation and patience during this period.

GP Service Update

Whilst works are ongoing on the Tredegar Health and Wellbeing Centre, we will still be providing services as usual and we will keep

you updated on arrangements as we transition to the new build.

Croeso i bedwerydd rhifyn newyddlenni Canolfan Iechyd a Lles Tredegar gan Kier Construction Cymru a'r Gorllewin mewn partneriaeth â Bwrdd Iechyd Prifysgol Aneurin Bevan (BIPAB).

Mae'n bleser gennym gyhoeddi bod y safle wedi cael ei enwi'n swyddogol yn Ganolfan Iechyd a Lles Bevan.

Y cyfleuster newydd, sydd i fod i gael ei gwblhau ym mis Ebrill 2023, yn cynnig amrywiaeth cynhwysfawr o wasanaethau Gofal Sylfaenol, Cymunedol, Gofal Cymdeithasol a Lles ar gyfer trigolion lleol mewn un lle hwylus.

Yn dilyn trafodaeth gyhoeddus am enw swyddogol y ganolfan, dewiswyd Canolfan Iechyd a Lles Bevan gan Ann Lloyd CBE, Cadeirydd Bwrdd Iechyd Prifysgol Aneurin Bevan, a Glyn Jones, y Prif Weithredwr Interim, o ddetholiad o enwau a gynigiwyd.

Dywedodd Ann Lloyd CBE, Cadeirydd Bwrdd Iechyd Prifysgol Aneurin Bevan: *"Cawsom awgrymiadau bendigedig am enwau posibl i'r adeilad newydd, ond i ni, Canolfan Iechyd a Lles Bevan oedd yr enw gorau ar gyfer canolfan a adeiladwyd yn nhref enedigol sylfaenydd y GIG."*

Dywedodd Glyn Jones, Prif Weithredwr Interim Bwrdd Iechyd Prifysgol Aneurin Bevan: *"Roedd hi'n anrhydedd cael dewis enw'r ganolfan, ac mae'n hyfryd cael gweld y gwaith adeiladu ar y cyfleuster newydd bendigedig yma a fydd yn darparu gwasanaethau gofal rhagorol yn agosach at filltir sgwâr ein trigolion."*
